ANNOUNCEMENT:

The West Leeds Motor Club Ltd. will organise a National Trial on Sunday 11th September 2016 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Trials Regulations of the ACU, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting. Three classes for Adults: White Rose Course, 50/50 & Clubman's course. (There will be dual sections to accommodate Clubman and 50/50 course riders).

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all members of ACU Affiliated Clubs. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials Registration card or ACU/SACU competition licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.

MACHINES:

Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

START/VENUE:

Start 10am at CAM HEAD, NR. HAWES. (A684 through Gayle). NORTH YORKSHIRE. Long/Lat: 54.244926 / - 2.266682. First two riders will start at 10.01 and then in pairs at one minute intervals. Clubman riders will start first followed by White Rose riders and 50/50 riders last. Rider numbers and start times will be posted on web site and to riders supplying an SAE for that purpose.

COURSE:

The course will consist of one lap and 40 sections in and around Hawes accessed by public highway.

The Time limit for the event will be allocated with your start time. Time penalties will be incurred 1 mark per minute up to a maximum of 20 minutes for late starting and late finishing and thereafter will be disqualified.

A part of the course will be passing by a Red Squirrel Conservation area at grid ref SD827 872 for approx 1 mile. There will be signs warning of this area. Please ride with extreme care at this point as there may also be young children about.

METHOD OF MARKING:

As per TSR22b; No-stop. Ties will be resolved as per TSR23.

PROTESTS:

As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section10.04.

GENERAL:

Two Cans of Petrol will be necessary. Fill up after first leg at car park. A petrol stop area will be signed at which you may deposit one can of petrol; the course will pass this area. (There will be NO transport of fuel around the course). Refreshments at start

RTA COVER:

Through the ACU Road Traffic Act Insurance Scheme, 3rd Party RTA insurance will be available at the start for competitors who are able to meet the requirements specified by the insurance company. (No additional charge will be levied for this cover). The machine which is entered and competed on must be suitable and proper for its purpose, shall be road legal and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof. All machines must display a number plate.

This event is held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto-Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued for the meeting.

The ACU National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations are published annually in the ACU Handbook.

ENTRY DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event I am entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU permitted competition or on the ACU Stop List as a result of incurring a Concussion injury.
- I accept that insurance arranged on my behalf by the organisers of events that I may enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in a high risk activity.
- I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course.
- I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
- I confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose. I confirm that I am eligible to compete on the machines for which I have entered.
- I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
- I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.
